

Party FAQs

Here are answers to some of the questions that we are frequently asked about our parties. If you have any other questions please don't hesitate to get in touch with us by phone 01763 249800 or email glazedcreationsroyston@gmail.com. We are happy to try to cater to your specific needs.

What are the minimum and maximum numbers for a party at Glazed Creations?

The minimum number of children is 10. If on the day you have fewer than 10 children we will invoice you for 10, sometimes this makes for a good opportunity for a parent to paint too!

The maximum number of children that we can allow into our party room is 14, the room is in our basement so we need to make sure we can safely get everyone out were we to have an emergency.

If you wish to hold a party with more than 14 painters then give us a call or drop us an email, we can hold larger parties in our main studio, subject to availability.

What snacks do you serve? Can I bring my own food?

We serve party snacks such as sweets, chocolate, crisps, popcorn, breadsticks, carrot or cucumber sticks and biscuits.

We advise against bringing your own food, there tends not to be a lot of time for eating at the party as the main emphasis is on the pottery painting and creating. We cannot have food out whilst the children are painting as grease and crumbs will ruin the glaze on their piece.

Do you provide a cake?

We do not provide a birthday cake, however there will be time at the end of the party for you to bring cake out and sing happy birthday. We do have knives and matches in the studio. We request that cakes do not have sparkler or excessively smokey candles as they set off our fire alarm (normal candles are fine!).

Can I bring my own decorations or party bags?

You are welcome to decorate the room if you wish, the room will be ready for you to enter about 10 minutes before your party is due to start. We will place a helium balloon on the table and the party room is decorated with bunting to give it more of a party feel.

We provide sweet cones for you to give the children at the end of the party, if you wish to bring your own party bags we have no objection, but most people find the sweet cones sufficient.

Can younger siblings come too?

Younger children may need assistance choosing the glazes and squeezing small amounts out. It is advisable to make sure that you have an adult to supervise them as your party host will be needed with the older children.

How many adults can stay?

We ask that no more than 2 adults stay with the party, but do require that at least one of adult remains in the room with our member of staff throughout the party. If you have guests that may require an adult to stay with them please discuss this with us in advance. The party will not begin until parents have all dropped off and left as children find it difficult to listen to our instruction over the background noise of parents chatting.

Our party is a joint party, can you do a second fingerprint party plate?

Yes we are happy to design a plate for both birthday children, we charge an additional £10 for the second plate.
